- The data collected will be anonymised and aggregated into a broader analysis which aims to gauge the approximate carbon footprint of the UK space sector through extrapolation techniques.
- This broader analysis will be presented to UKRI, UKspace and the UKSA in the form of a report, with no identifiable company information being put into the public domain (NDAs can be signed).
